



The South properties are landfills of Waste Management preventing the alignment from moving East. To the North is the Pioneer Elementary school preventing the alignment from going farther West. Development is 119 acres, proposed disturbed area is 36 acres. Looks like they may have to move the drainage pit to the East side of the property (Or make multiple smaller drainage pits.)


