

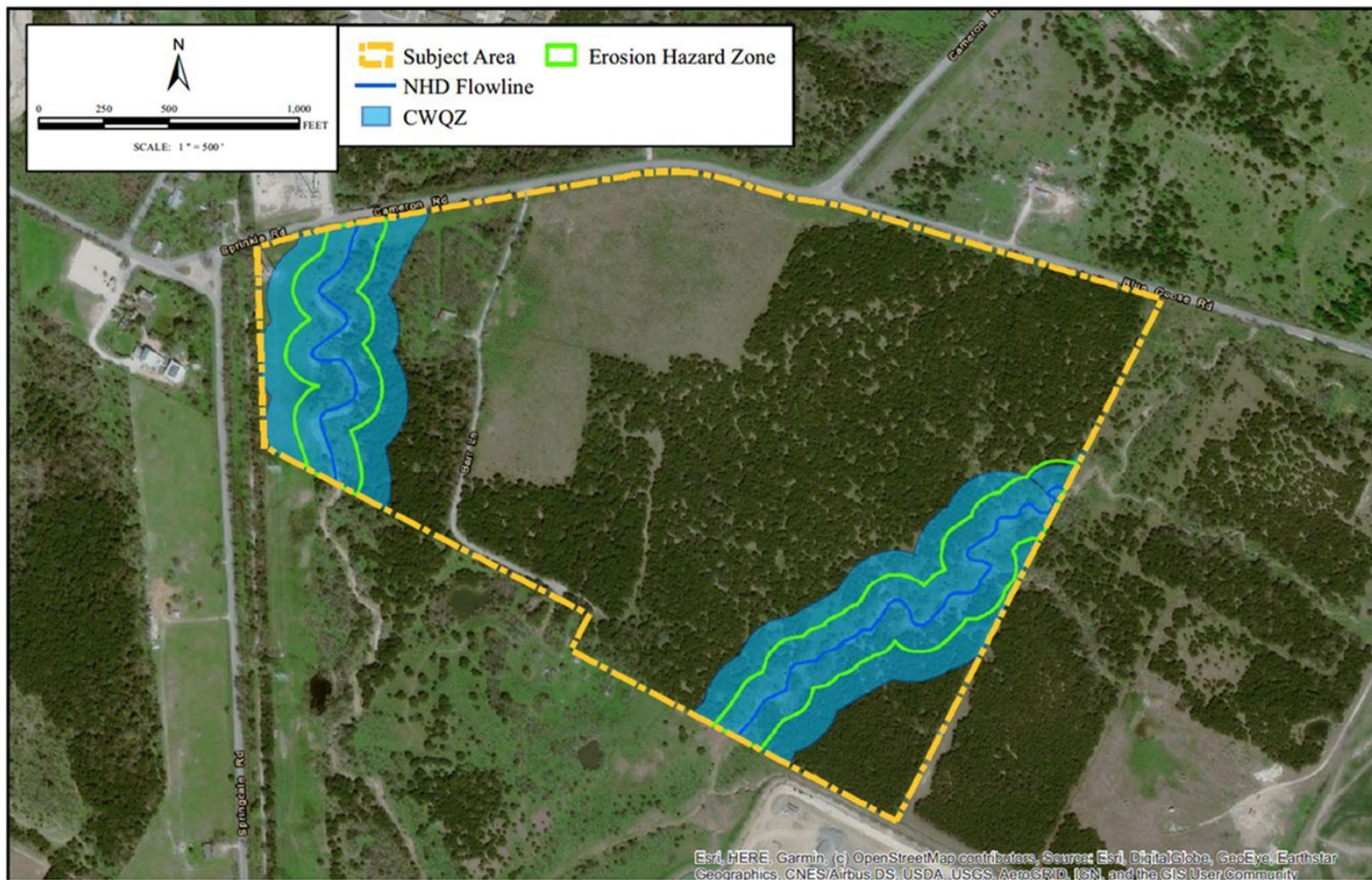

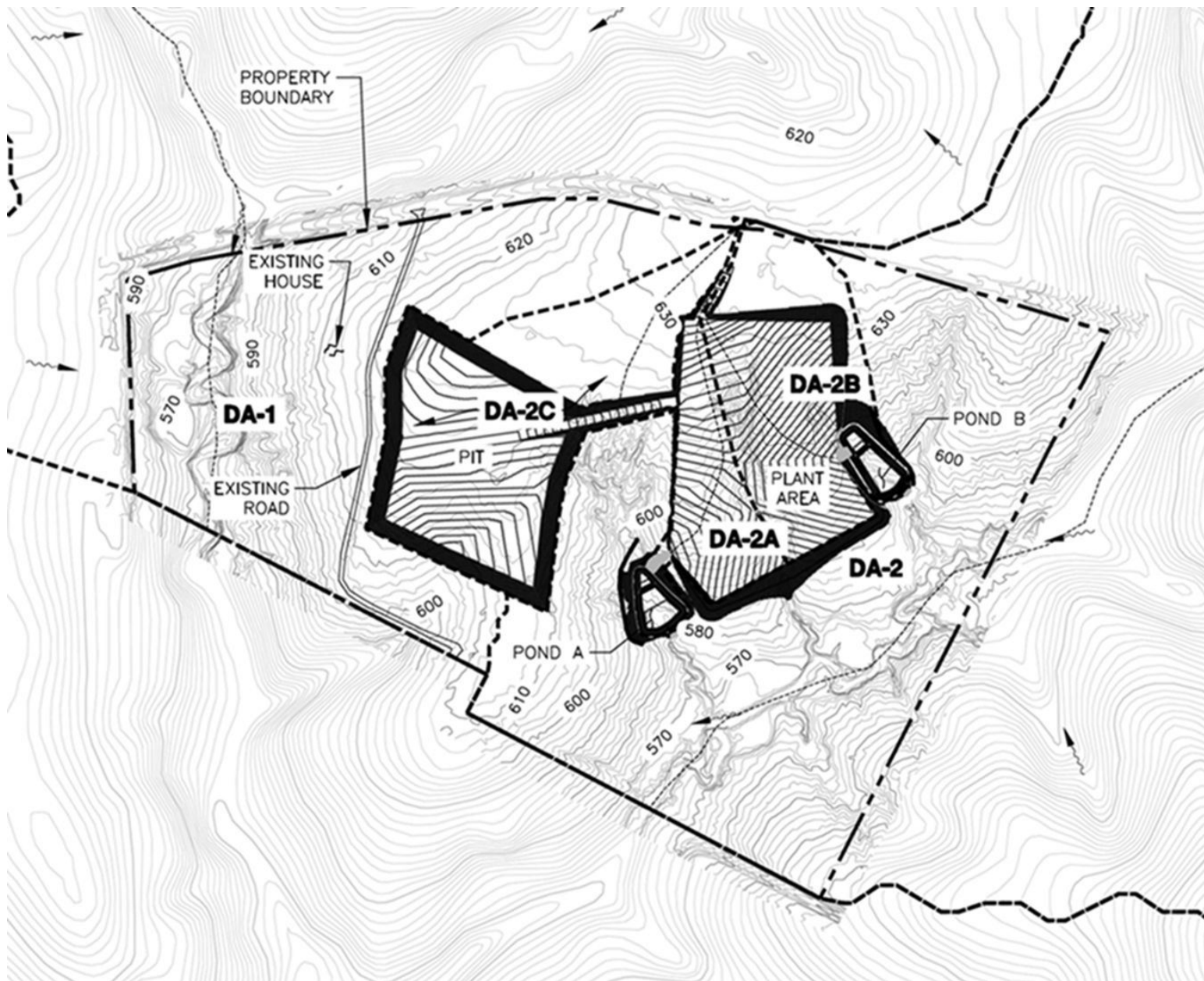

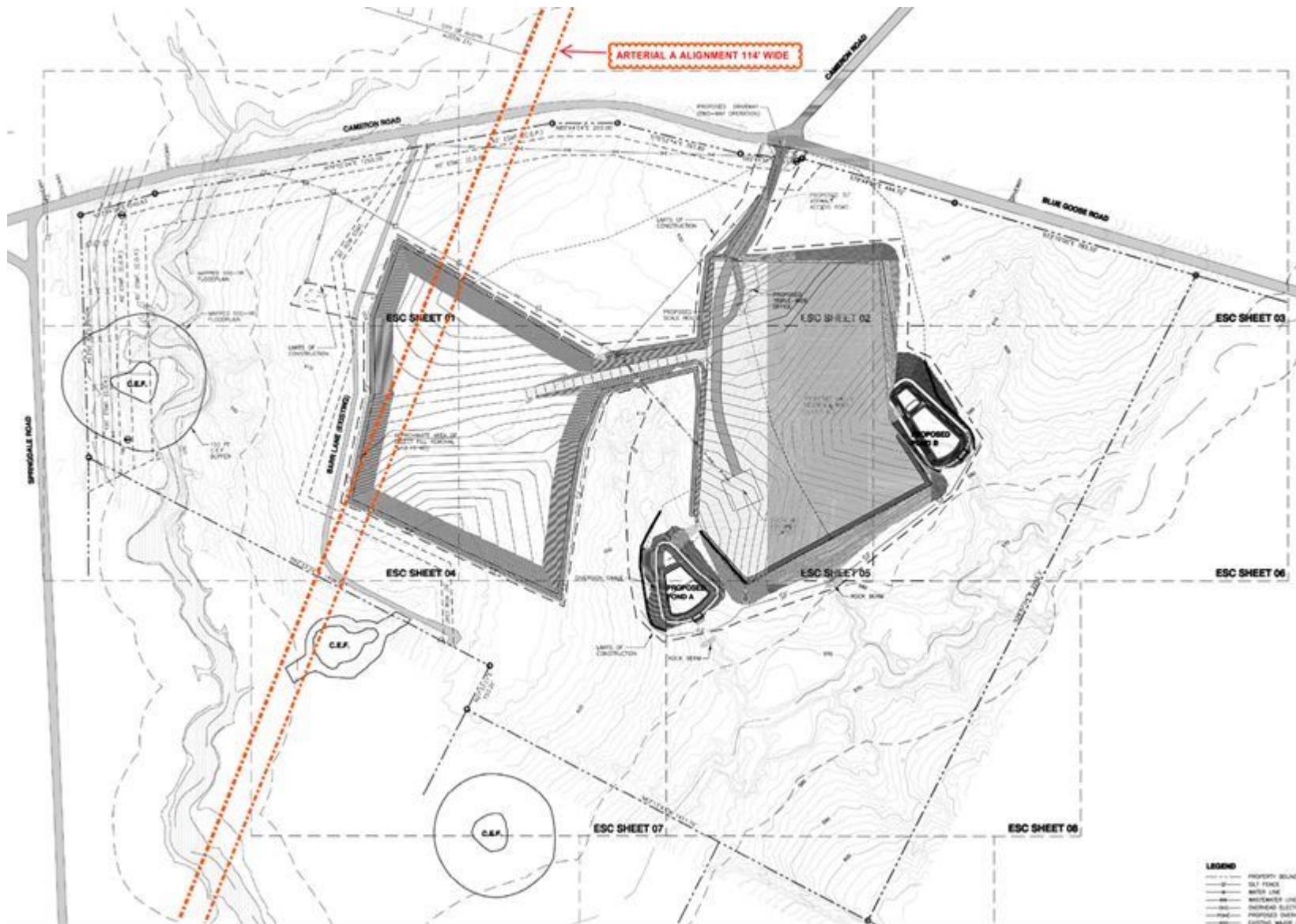

I write to ask all of you to oppose the concrete recycling plant proposed at the intersection of Springdale Road and Blue Goose. (#3 on attached map)

As you know, roads in this area were not built to accommodate the numbers and kinds of trucks necessary to operate a concrete recycling plant. Such a plant will produce noise, air pollution, and environmental damage that will reduce the quality of life not only in Walnut Place but Colonial Place, Chimney Hill, and Pioneer Crossing East (with homes just on the other side of Blue Goose). And--the historic Barr Mansion is across Springdale from this proposed facility.

The preferred route for Arterial A goes through this property. This route was meticulously studied with neighborhood input several years ago. I pray Travis County will not change the route of Arterial A to accommodate a proposed cement recycling plant.

We request that Walnut Place and other involved neighborhoods and land owners be kept informed of any developments or changes to this permit.
